

# 2016 Old Portage Klondike



## Mountaineers of Manatoc

The Old Portage Klondike will be returning to Camp Manatoc 1/29/16- 1/31/16 with the headquarters at the Training Lodge. Every unit (Boy Scout and Crews) from the district are urged to participate. The Mountain Men of Manatoc theme will bring back some old time feel to some of the typical Scouting events. We will be making some slight changes from last year. The event will contain a travois race and ten patrol stations on Saturday. We will be having a movie on Saturday evening along with the awards ceremony on Saturday night. Below is the list of events currently planned for the 2016 Klondike. We look forward to seeing you all there for the District event of the year.

### Ten Saturday Patrol Events

Archery	Orienteering
Ax and Saw	Knots and Lashings
Fire Building	First Aid
Tomahawk Throwing	Log Cabin Building
Knife Throwing	Tracking

Each patrol will guide their Klondike sled from one event station to another during the day on Saturday. At each station the team will have a skill to demonstrate. Each activity will have a point value and most will be timed. The winner is the Troop that has the highest average score of its patrol/sled teams. Scoring will be averaged based on the size and number of patrols. At each station, there will be adult leaders in charge, they will be handing out points and keeping times. They will be judging everything, including scout spirit, or lack of it, and if the sled team listened to and followed instructions. There will also be a race to finish off the competition on Saturday afternoon. We are providing 10 event stations to allow variety and give patrols a choice. Each patrol should visit a minimum of 8 stations but can visit more, time permitting. Score utilized for overall results will be the top 8 scoring events from each patrol.

Leaders – Volunteers are needed for each event as well as race stations. We need to have at least one member from each unit to man stations for the race. We need to have at least two adults at each station.
