## Yukon Trail- The Search for Gold

### Get ready for the event of the year, the Old Portage Cub Scout and Boy Scout Klondike.

That's right, two Klondike's, on the same day at the same location. The Old Portage Klondike will be returning to Camp Manatoc 1/27/17- 1/29/17 with the headquarters at the Training Lodge. This year we will be running two events, one for Boy Scouts and Crews and the other for Cub Scouts. Every unit (Boy Scout, Crews and Cub Packs) from the district are urged to participate. "Yukon Trail- The Search for Gold" will be the theme this year. The Boy Scout event will contain a race and ten patrol stations on Saturday. The Cub event will contain a race with eight event stations on Saturday. Lunch will be provided for the Cub Scouts and leaders on Saturday. Below is the list of events planned. We look forward to seeing you all there for the District event of the year.

Each patrol and den will guide their Klondike sled through the event stations on Saturday. At each station the team will have a skill or activity to demonstrate.

- For Boy Scouts, each activity will have a point value and most will be timed. The winner is the Troop that has the highest average score of its patrol/sled teams. Scoring will be averaged based on the size and number of patrols. At each station, there will be adult leaders in charge, they will be handing out points and keeping times. They will be judging everything, including scout spirit, or lack of it, and if the sled team listened to and followed instructions. There will also be a race to finish off the competition on Saturday afternoon. We are providing 10 event stations to allow variety and give patrols a choice. Each patrol should visit a minimum of 8 stations but can visit more, time permitting. Score utilized for overall results will be the top 8 scoring events from each patrol.
- For Cub Scouts, all Dens and Packs will be recognized for their participation. There will also be a race to finish off the competition on Saturday afternoon. We are providing 8 event stations and encourage each sled team to visit all 8 stations. Registration is listed below.
